### Course Overview

This is a 14 hour Advanced Incident Command System for Expanding Incidents course that provides training on and resources for personnel who require advanced application of the ICS. This course expands upon information covered in the ICS-100 through ICS-300 courses.

### Target Audiences

The target audience for this course includes senior personnel who are expected to perform in a management capacity at an incident or event. This includes individuals who may serve as Incident Commander or as members of the Command or General Staff, Area Command, or multiagency coordination entity/Emergency Operations Center (EOC) management.

### Prerequisites

**Required:** ICS-100, ICS-200, ICS-300, IS-700.  
**Recommended:** Command or general staff  
experience & IS-800

### Cost

There is no fee for the course. Lunch and travel expenses are the responsibility of the participant.
