



# SAFETY SEMINARS

Three of the most potentially hazardous safety issues facing water and wastewater professionals are Confined Space Entry, Lockout/Tagout and Chlorine Safety (including hypochlorite). These three operations represent *routine* hazards for operators. Consequently, training on these procedures is essential to help ensure worker safety. On January 27<sup>th</sup>, OXARC will present training on all three topics. You can participate in all three sessions for a special rate, or you can choose to participate in the session of greatest interest to you.

**Chlorine Safety** (8:00am-10:45am): Chlorine is among the most widely used chemicals in the industry today. Its presence is so familiar to most employees that it is easy to forget that chlorine is also one of the most potentially hazardous chemicals used in the workplace. This seminar is designed to help employees understand the characteristics of chlorine, the potential hazards associated with its use, and methods for safe handling. The seminar will also cover the selection of personal protective equipment, proper SCBA practices and first aid responses to chlorine exposures. Attendees will also learn how to inspect, transport, maintain, and use a chlorine "A" kit.

**Lockout/Tagout** (11:00am-12:00pm): One of the leading causes of severe workplace injuries and death is maintenance and repair activities on or around energized equipment. In this class, you will learn: 1) Lock Out/Tag Out definitions according to DOSH/OSHA; 2) How to implement and enforce LO/TO procedures in your workplace; 3) How to develop a method of evaluating your present LO/TO program; 4) Conducting risk assessments to determine site-specific LO/TO requirements; 5) Key steps for implementing a successful LO/TO program.

**Confined Space Entry** (1:00pm-4:00pm): Confined Space Entry presents a number of safety challenges for employers and workers alike. Found in thousands of work environments, confined spaces are unique: Every confined space has distinct characteristics as well as real and potential hazards. Consequently, a thorough assessment of each confined space must be made in order to ensure worker safety. This critical process can only be accomplished when the employer and the workers involved in the entry understand the complexities involved in conducting thorough confined space hazard assessments. Those assessments must then be applied in combination with well thought out entry procedures. This version of OXARC's Confined Space Entry Seminar is organized to provide participants with the essential elements of conducting a safe confined space entry. The Confined Space Seminar will include a classroom presentation on CSE regulations and practices, followed by a discussion of air monitoring/gas detection considerations.
