- A. **Minutes** – Motion by Chief Crawford, seconded by Chief Sampert, to accept the minutes of the July meeting, motion passed.
- B. **Treasurer's Report** – Chief Borders gave the Treasurer's Report. Received was the grant funds from BLM for the academy. Motion by Chief Marcus, seconded by Chief Rohrwasser, to accept the Treasurers Report, motion passed.
- C. **Committee Reports**
 - a. Training Committee: The committee is starting to work on the 2011 academy, anyone with input should forward suggestions to Chief Maines.
 - b. The Flashover trailer will be in the area in September.
 - c. BHS is planning on the ICS academy for next spring, anyone with personnel interested in position specific training should plan on attending.

 - e. Northern Lakes is sponsoring NFA class in Hayden.
- D. CISD organization is still pending, Chief Sampert suggested that outlining a structure would probably be most useful as a first step, and then look at an operational plan. Chiefs Crawford and Simms will continue to work on this.
- E. Status of the MedStar proposal for emergency responders is still pending, Tony will inquire as to status.
